### ABSTRACT

---

The Wistariahurst Institutional History Collection is the institutional history of the museum, which is also a cultural center and city department. It contains records of most all the activities and programs run by the organization as found in internal planning documents and press coverage; planning, development and fundraising activities; use and maintenance of the gardens, grounds and buildings; finance and staff records; supporting organizations; and photographs. The bulk of materials and most interesting are in the scrapbook and news clippings which document the history of the museum, as well as the events and programming files. These series show the vast amount of programming the museum has been involved with over the years.

### HISTORICAL NOTE

---

Wistariahurst originally stood in Skinnerville, but the devastating Mill River flood in 1874 led William Skinner to dismantle the mansion and reconstruct it in Holyoke. In 1901 the estate was officially named by the family, for the wisteria vines that Sarah Skinner planted in the late 1880s which grew around the mansion. The Skinner family lived in Wistariahurst for two generations, and during that time many changes and additions were made to the estate. These changes include the addition of the Conservatory and Music Hall in 1913 to house Belle Skinner's collection of musical instruments; the construction of the Marble Lobby and Main Hall in 1927; and changing of the entrance of the home to Beech Street. The two lions that sit at the entrance, purchased in Rome in the 1880s, were also moved to Cabot Street during this time and have become as much an emblem of the museum as the wisteria vines.

In 1959 Wistariahurst was deeded to the City of Holyoke by Katherine Skinner Kilborne and her children so that it could be a cultural and educational center for Holyoke. In April 1960 the Holyoke Museum, originally housed on the second floor of the Holyoke Public Library, found its new home in Wistariahurst. Over time the museum has evolved to become an historic house museum that tells the story of Holyoke and her inhabitants, including the Skinner family. In 1973 Wistariahurst was listed on the National Register of Historic Places, and it is a Department of the City of Holyoke supported by Historic Holyoke at Wistariahurst, Inc. The Holyoke Youth

Museum, originally located in the Carriage House, was closed in 1990 and the Carriage House became a visitor's center and home of the archives.

In its shift from private residence to historical and cultural center, Wistariahurst has been managed and overseen by various city departments, commissions and supported by other organizations. It has served as a history center, a children's museum, a natural history museum, a gardening support center, a concert hall, a wedding venue and a space for various public and private events.

### SCOPE AND CONTENTS OF THE COLLECTION

---

The Wistariahurst Institutional History Collection consists of 26 linear feet of material, dating from 1918-2016. Material formats include scrapbooks, news clippings, photographs and negatives, guest books and attendance records, developmental and organization documents, programming, financial records, and material related to the gardens and grounds. The predominant theme of the collection is the history and development of the museum over the years and the functions that it has served in the Holyoke community.

### REPOSITORY INFORMATION

---

The Wistariahurst Museum Archives are located in the Carriage House of the Museum property. The Archive hosts several main research collections: The Skinner Family Collection; The Textile Collection, containing many examples of Skinner Satin Wedding Dresses; The Holyoke

Collection, a general archive relating to the History of the City of Holyoke as a whole; The Carlos Vega Collection of Latino History in Holyoke; The Magoon Collection, relating to the History of Papermaking in Holyoke. The Museum encourages patrons to come and view the Archives for educational and recreational purposes.

The Wistariahurst Museum Archives are available for public use by appointment. Finding Aids for The Skinner Family Collection, The Holyoke Collection and the Vega Collection, listing box and folder locations, are available for patrons on the Wistariahurst.org website, or to look through in person at the archive. Materials may be request by completing a provided Call Slip which includes collection name, box number, and folder number of the material. The staff person on duty will retrieve the requested items from the Archives. Only staff persons are allowed in the Archives storage area.

Researchers are not allowed to copy, scan, or photograph material without Museum permission. In most instances you will be allowed to take digital photographs without a flash. If you would prefer a photocopy, scan, or photograph of a document, you must complete a photocopy request form and there is a fee. Depending on the item's condition, the staff person will make the copy or scan for you, or instruct you on taking the photograph as to not harm the item. The staff person on duty has the right to refuse to copy, scan, or allow a photograph to be taken based on his or her assessment of the condition of the item.

Patrons must ask permission from the Museum Curator to use items in a publication. Only the curator may give permission. He or she will review the items on a case-by- case basis, and will inform patrons if restrictions exist. In the event that permission is granted, the curator will provide the patron with a use agreement. The proper citation for these items is: "This photograph is courtesy of the Wistariahurst Museum, Holyoke, Massachusetts." Some items may be under copyright and unavailable for publication. The owner of that copyright must be contacted to allow usage of their items.

Series 1 has been subdivided into four subseries: scrapbooks, news clippings, press releases & publicity, and history. Subseries 1a contains scrapbooks contain albums with pasted in news clippings of every mention of Wistariahurst or the Holyoke Museum dating back to 1918. Subseries 1b consists of folders containing loose clippings from newspapers and some photocopies of clipping, some of which are duplicates of clippings that appear in the scrapbooks. Subseries 1c contains bound volumes of press releases and publicity relating to Wistariahurst dating from 1959 to 2012. Subseries 1d contains files related to the history of the museum as written by previous directors and staff, as well as correspondence with Holyoke Youth Museum director Marie S. Quirk and clippings related to her firing.

### **Series 2. GUEST BOOKS AND ATTENDANCE** (2 boxes; 2 linear ft)

Series 2 has been subdivided into two subseries: guest books and attendance. Subseries 2a contains guest books and tourist registers filled out by visitors to the museum that date between 1960 and 2010. Subseries 2b contains bound attendance records for the museum that date between 1979 and 2012.

Series 3 consists of photo albums and folders of various events and programs that took place at Wistariahurst over the years, including volunteer dinner events, youth activities, and photos documenting repair and construction at the museum.

Series 4 has been subdivided into six subseries: development and fundraising, events and programs, gardens, grounds, and building, finances, memberships and organizations, and planning. Subseries 4a contains developmental and fundraising items such as layouts for the museum brochure, management policies and procedures, director newsletters and reports, resumes for prospective director and event coordinator candidates, fundraising letters, visitor surveys and research, and the institutional plan. Subseries 4b contains events and programs that took place at Wistariahurst, including professional development programs, the oral history

project sponsored by Wistariahurst, and collections of events based on year from 1963 to 1996. Subseries 4c has folders of rental agreements for special events from 1984 to 1999, invoices, memorial funds, completed functions, and files related to the special revenue account. Subseries 4d consists of material related to the gardens, grounds and buildings on the estate, especially including floor plans, manuals, and correspondences related to the Carriage House renovation in 2009. Subseries 4e includes material on the memberships and organizations that Wistariahurst was involved with, including local and national organizations. Subseries 4f consists of bound planners that span from 2004 to 2016.

### **Series 5. MISCELLANEOUS** (1 box; 1 linear ft)

Series 5 contains miscellaneous items including outdated museum inventories and finding aids, old docent manuals, copies of magazines that featured articles on Wistariahurst, maps of the Holyoke area, and a hand-drawn book donated by a patron.
